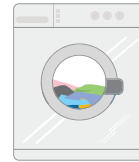


Mac-Gray's Laundry 101 has the info you need most

	Water Temperature
Whites	Hot
Colors	Warm
Perm-Press	Warm
Delicates	Warm
Bright Colors	Cold
Woolens	Cold

: Cold water cleans effectively and saves energy.

Lint Screen: Cleaning the lint screen promotes maximum air flow and saves energy

Washer Load: One washer load equals one dryer load, and remember to read clothing tags to make sure they are safe for drying.

Door Lock: Dryer will stop if door is opened during cycle.

Stain Removal: Pre-treat stain and wash in hottest water safe for fabric.

Nail Polish Stain: Place stain face down on paper towels. Sponge with nail polish remover until stain disappears. Rinse thoroughly. Do not use nail polish remover on acetate or Arnel fabrics.

Blood Stain: Sponge promptly with cold water or soak in cold water. Pre-treat remaining stain. Wash in hottest water safe for fabric.
